## **PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE**

### **Background**

Kamakhya Ram Barooah Girls' college, situated on the M. B. Road, Fatashil, Guwahati was established on 14th April 1971, with the objective of advancement of women's education in the western part of Guwahati. The people of this western part of Guwahati long felt the need of such an institution in this area. Accordingly, an initiative had been taken by some prominent citizens of the locality. The plot of land was obtained from the Govt. of Assam and the fund for the construction of the main college building and for the development of the college was donated by Late Prabir Ram Barooah, in the name of his father Late Kamakhya Ram Barooah, who was a renowned advocate, social worker, philanthropist and a pioneer of women's education in Assam. The foundation stone was laid by Late Mohendra Mohan Choudhury, the then chief Minister of Assam. Since then the college is striving for the enlightenment, progress and all round development, of the young women student of the locality. The college has so far produced a number of well established professionals in various fields.

# ADOPTION OF CBCS IN COLLEGE AT BA/BSC (HOME SCIENCE) LEVEL

## ACADEMIC SESSION : 2019-2020

The college has adopted the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) per GU notification dated 13th May, 2019 at the B.A. / B.Sc. (Home Science) level for the Academic Session 2019-2020. Under this system, students are given a much wider choice of courses along with Ability and Skill Enhancement courses in the curriculum to be compulsorily studied by all the undergraduate students.

**Courses and Credits under CBCS :** Credit indicates hours of instruction. 1 credit is equivalent to one hour of classroom instruction for theory classes and 2 hours of instructions in practical classes, Under CBCS, the courses and their respective credits are shown below :

1. **Core Course :** These are discipline specific compulsory papers to be studied by the students. The papers under this category are going to be taught uniformly across all universities. All the papers under this category will carry 6 credits each.
2. **Elective course :** Two types of elective courses are included under CBCS.
  - i) Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) courses : These elective papers are related to the Core disciplines chosen by the students. Students will have to select the required number of DSE papers from among the choices available in an institute. These courses/papers will have 6 credits each.
  - ii) Generic Elective (GE) courses : Students will have to choose these elective papers which are not related to their core discipline(s). This will give the students exposure beyond their main discipline of choice. These papers will also have 6 credits each.
3. **Ability Enhancement Courses :** These Courses are aimed at increasing ability and skills of the students to enhance their employability. There are two components-
  - i) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) : All the students will have to study two courses/papers carrying 4 credits each.
    - a) English / MIL Communication.
    - b) Environmental Studies.
  - ii) Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) : The students will have choice of selecting the required Skill courses based on their interest from the pool of the courses offered by the institute. These courses will have 4 credits each.

The students will have to initiate their choices / preferences of Honours / Regular Courses in the appropriate place in the Application Form. The College will allocate the desired choices of the students on the basis of merit and subject to availability of seats. For GE Courses, the students can indicate the choices when the session begins.

### **Admission Procedure and Fee Structure**

**Admission: General Information :**

- (i) Soon after the announcement of the results of the different Examinations (SEBA, AHSEC, GU) the notice and advertisement for admission in H.S. and B.A. courses

are given in the college Notice Board, College Website and local daily newspapers. Interested students are required to contact the college office for the prospectus and the admission forms on the payment of a fee.

- (ii) Considerable number of seats are reserved for S.T., S.C. & M.O.B.C. students etc. as per Government regulations.

### **Documents to be submitted for Admission :**

At the time of admission, candidates should submit the following documents :

(iv) Gap certificates for students passed before the current academic year. The students seeking admission will have to appear before an interview board on the date of admission notified. The students will have to produce all the relevant original certificates for verification.

### **Code of conduct of the college & student's responsibility.**

#### **Code of conduct :**

- (i) The students must come to the college wearing the college uniform. Otherwise the students will not be allowed to enter the college campus. The detailed information regarding the college uniform may be obtained from the college office.
- (ii) Discipline must be maintained at any cost. The students cannot leave college without attending the classes.
- (iii) Admission will be cancelled if anybody is found absent for continuously 15 days without information.
- (iv) Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- (v) A student who fails to pay their fees in time will not be allowed to attend the classes and appear in the qualifying examinations.
- (vi) The materials required for different courses will have to be brought by the students.
- (vii) Use of Mobile Phone by students inside the College campus is strictly prohibited.
- (viii) Ragging is strictly prohibited. Any one found indulging in any act of ragging will be dealt with as per the guidelines of UGC and DHE, Govt. of Assam.**

#### **ANTI RAGGING POLICY OF THE COLLEGE :**

Considering the disastrous effect of ragging, ragging has been declared as a criminal offence and regulations has been framed by UGC and State Higher Education Authorities for curbing the menace in institutions of higher education. Strong disciplinary measures have been prescribed which may include rustication from college and police case.

#### **ix) Attendance :**

The students should attend the classes regularly. They must attend at least 75% of the classes failing which they will be debarred from appearing in the examination. **Students coming regularly to classes will get maximum 4 points in respective internal assessments of the subject papers (B.A course).** The points so earned shall later be added to the marks obtained in the final examinations.

**(x) Identity Card :**

A non transferrable identity card is issued to each student on admission to the College. The card containing relevant information of the holder, together with the recent passport size photograph must be duly endorsed by the Principal of the college. The card is essential for identification and consideration of any claim by the student concerned.

**(xi) College Uniform :**

Students shall have to come to the college in college uniform prescribed by the college. The college uniform is

**COLLEGE LIBRARY**

The College Library is well equipped with text and reference books, encyclopedia,



and good number of magazines, news papers and other periodicals. The Students can access them in the reading room attached. The Library cards are issued to the bonafide students of the college to borrow the books from the library. The students will have to return the books within the fixed period of time, failing which they will have to pay a fine. Book-bank facility is also available for the needy students. To facilitate e-learning a computer has been installed for the students in the library with internet facility.

### **LIBRARY RULES**

1. Book are issued for fifteen days against each card.
2. Two extra books are issued for fifteen days against each major card.
3. The owner of the card is entitled to borrow one book from the library.
4. Re-issue of the same book is permitted if it is not demanded by others.
5. For loss of books or any kind of damage to it, the prescribed cost of the book, along with a suitable fine will be charged for each day.
6. Books should be returned on or before the due date, failing which 1 (one) rupee fine will be charged for each day.
7. A sum of Rs. 10/- will be charged for the loss of the card.
8. The librarian may recall a book at any time.
9. The teaching staff can borrow ten (10) books at a time.
10. The Librarian has the discretionary power to lend more books to the readers in certain special circumstances.
11. Books are issued from 10 a.m to 3 p.m on each working day.
12. The working days of the library is as per the GU calendar.

### **Student's facilities and other programmes :**

- a) Campus :** The College campus has recently been upgraded to Wi-Fi campus to facilitate easy access of knowledge of the students and staff members.
- b) College canteen :** Canteen services within the campus are available - for K.R.B. students, staff and faculty members.
- c) Photostat machine :** The students can get their documents photocopied at a concessional rate at the college campus.
- d) Gym :** The College runs a Gym for the students. It is equipped with the equipments required to maintain a good physique and good health.
- e) The College Auditorium :** The College Auditorium which was constructed

with the financial assistance of M.P. fund of Dr. Manmohan Singh, Former Prime Minister of India in July 2001. The seminars, college functions, meetings are held in the auditorium.

- f) Scholarship :** The various State and Central Govt. Scholarship such as National Merit, State Merit Scholarships and Scholarships for S.T./S.T./ M.O.B.C./ Minority and Differently abled students are provided as per the provisions of the government. The students are required to fill up the scholarship forms available in the office from time to time.
- g) Women's Hostel:** The Women's Hostel of the College is presently under construction.
- h) Remedial Coaching Classes :** The college makes arrangements for Remedial Coaching Classes specially for academically weaker students, free of cost.
- i) Internet Facility :** College has provided internet facility for staff and students in the library as well as in the departments.
- j) Sports Facilities :** The college provides a synthetic court for various games like volley ball, basket ball and badminton etc.
- k) Computer Lab :** The college has a computer lab for the benefit of the students where a number of certificate courses are offered.
- l) Language Lab :** The college has a language lab where the students are given the opportunity to learn the English language with the help of a software specifically designed to enhance their proficiency.
- m) Smart Classroom :** The college has a smart classroom where the students can avail the benefits of audio-visual teaching facilities.

#### **Other Programmes for the Students :**

- i) Student Union :** The Student Union is formed in a democratic manner under the active guidance of the Prof in-charge. The Students union hold many competitions in Literary and Cultural Activities, games and sports.
- ii) College Week :** It is observed with the active participation of the students in the month of Dec/Jan. Literary competitions, Cultural competitions, minor games and major games competitions are held. The winners are rewarded with medals and trophies.
- iii) Fresher's social :** The Fresher's Social is held in the month of August to welcome the freshers in a befitting manner.
- iv) Parting Social :** The outgoing students of the college i.e. the students of the B.A. 6th semester are given a farewell by the Staff and the Students of the College in a grand manner.

Saraswati Puja is observed by the students of the college with a great deal of enthusiasm, and religious fervor.

**iii. Seminars and popular Lecture :**

College organizes a number of National & State level Seminars sponsored mainly by U.G.C. Popular lectures are frequently organized by the departments of the college by inviting distinguished academicians to impart knowledge to the students.
